Snow Days and Delayed Openings

As the winter continues and the threat of snow and ice is ever-present, please listen to KYW or one of the TV stations regarding whether or not we are open. As an Archdiocesan school, we do not make the decision as to close due to inclement weather. That is made by the Office of Catholic Education. Please listen for "ALL ARCHDIOCESAN (or Parochial) SCHOOLS ARE CLOSED TODAY" or "THERE WILL BE A 2 HOUR DELAY THIS MORNING FOR ALL ARCHDIOCESAN SCHOOLS." Please do not call the school. If we get the word soon enough, we will post it on the school website or send out an email but it is best to just listen to the radio or television for the announcement.

Be aware that a 2 hour delay means that school will start at 10:00 and the breezeway doors will not open until 9:45. Also, there is NO morning CARES if there is a delayed opening.

New Student Registration for 2017-2018

The dates have been set to register new students. They are Tuesday, February 7, 8:30-10:30 AM & 1:00-3:00 PM and Wednesday, February 8, 5:00 – 7:00 PM. Be aware that PreK and K fill up quickly so if you are planning to register another child or have friends or families who wish to register, please encourage them to do so during these two days. If there are still openings after these dates, we will take new student registrations by appointment only. Re- Registration for 2017-2018

Now that February is here we need to start thinking about the 2017-2018 school year. Registration for new students is already underway and we have received a number of registrations for PK. Word is spreading throughout the community of what a great school we have! On Friday, you will be receiving a form for you to indicate your **Intent to Return** to Resurrection for the 2017-2018 school year. It is very important that you complete this form and return it to your child's teacher. This will help us determine how many openings we have in the grades as well as how many classes we will have for each grade.

Along with your Intent to Return Form, you will also receive a Re-Registration Form from the rectory indicating your payment plan for tuition. FACTS will continue to be our Tuition Management Company. You may send in your registration fee or pay it through FACTS as before. Any family already registered has been re-enrolled for the 2017-2018 school year. If you intend to keep the same tuition plan arrangement as last year, you do not need to do anything. If you want to change your plan or your banking information has changed, you must log onto your FACTS account at <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3PMQG> and make the necessary changes. The tuition manager, Nadine Holzshu will be entering your tuition rate based on your status and tuition plan that you select. 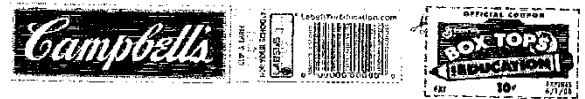
Track News
