- Box Top Postage - \$72

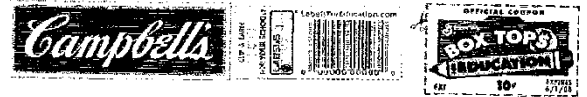


New Pastor and Principal
