Student DROP-OFF in the Morning

Now that the nice weather is here, students will be congregating in the schoolyard in the morning. In order to keep all children safe and our tempers in check in the early morning, we ask that all parents abide by the following rules:

1. No one should be parking their car along the curb on Shelmire or Vista. Please just pull up to the curb and stop long enough for your child to safely get out of the car and then pull carefully back out into traffic.
2. If you feel the need to get out of your car and walk your child to the schoolyard, then you must park your car in an appropriate spot. (The Acme parking lot is ideal.)
3. Please do not pull up on the side of the street opposite the school and try to cross your child there. All children and parents who get out of a car on the side of the street opposite the school must walk the child to the corner and cross with the crossing guard.

Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. If we all just follow these three simple rules, all our children will be safe and everyone will have a much happier start to the day.

Re- Registration for 2017-2018

Don't forget to send in your Re-Registration Form indicating your payment plan for tuition if you have not already done so. **Remember that the registration fee goes up to \$250 after April 30th. All registration fees must be paid by check, cash or money order and sent in to school or deposited at the rectory.** Previous News and Notes indicated that your registration fee could be paid through FACTS. The tuition manager, Nadine Holzshu, has informed us that was incorrect and all FACTS accounts will be pending until your registration fee is paid. **Any family already registered has been re-enrolled in FACTS for the 2017-2018 school year. If you intend to keep the same tuition plan arrangement as last year, you do not need to do anything. If you want to change your plan or your banking information has changed, you must log onto your FACTS account at <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3PMQG> and make the necessary changes.**

Nadine will be entering your tuition rate based on your status and tuition plan that you select. FACTS will then email you a payment schedule listing the dates and the amounts to pay. If you have any questions about tuition, please call Nadine at the rectory, 215-745-3211.

- To apply for BRIDGE, download the application here (application) or from the Parent Resources/Scholarships link on the school website. Complete the application and return it to school with the financial information required.

Bridge Educational Foundation

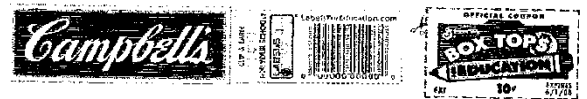
