## Student DROP-OFF in the Morning

Some parents who are dropping their children off after the first bell are driving into the schoolyard. This has created an unsafe situation since the children have always walked through the schoolyard to get to the breezeway doors. This morning, a parent almost backed into a child in the schoolyard. A little reminder is needed of the rules for dropping your children off in the morning.

**When the weather is nice, students are to meet in the schoolyard prior to the ringing of the first bell at 7:50 AM. If the weather is rainy or too cold, students wait in the cafeteria where their teacher will meet them and walk them up to class. Shelmire Ave. and Vista St. are DROP-OFF zones only meaning that you should just stop briefly to let your child out of the car. Parents should NOT park their cars there. If you feel the need to get out of the car with your child, and walk him or her to the school door, please park in an appropriate spot and walk with your child to school. Please do NOT cross the street except at the designated corners where there is a crossing guard. Never drive into the schoolyard or park your car there, even if the students are not present.**

Thank you for your cooperation with these procedures. Your child's safety is our utmost priority.

## Re- Registration for 2017-2018

Don't forget to send in your Re-Registration Form indicating your payment plan for tuition if you have not already done so. Remember that the registration fee goes up to \$250 after April 30<sup>th</sup>. FACTS will continue to be our Tuition Management Company. You may send in your registration fee or pay it through FACTS as before. **Any family already registered has been re-enrolled for the 2017-2018 school year. If you intend to keep the same tuition plan arrangement as last year, you do not need to do anything. If you want to change your plan or your banking information has changed, you must log onto your FACTS account at <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3PMQG> and make the necessary changes.** The tuition manager, Nadine Holzshu, will be entering your tuition rate based on your status and tuition plan that you select. FACTS will then email you a payment schedule listing the dates and the amounts to pay. If you have any questions about tuition, please call Nadine at the rectory, 215-745-3211.

## Box Tops and Labels for Education

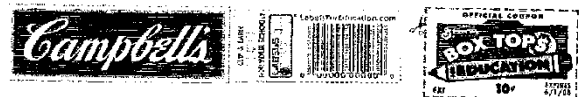
