Arrival Procedures

Students using the morning CARES program may arrive at school at 6:30. All other students may begin to arrive at school at 7:30. Breakfast is available for those students until 7:45. All students will enter school and proceed to the gym and wait in assigned classroom lines. All CARES students and students in the breakfast area will be directed to the gym at 7:45. At 7:50 we will begin morning prayer and announcements. Students will be dismissed from the gym at 8:00. Students arriving after 8:05 must enter the school through the main doors and they will be marked late.

Dismissal Procedures

Students will report to the school hall with their teachers at 2:50 PM and sit in designated areas as per their dismissal assignment. When all classes are present we will begin with any end of day announcements and end of day prayer. Students will then be dismissed in an orderly manner according to dismissal assignment. Car Line will be dismissed first in order to clear the schoolyard for the other lines

Kindergarten children are dismissed at 2:40 PM and parents are expected to meet them at the end of the ramp in the schoolyard. PreKindergarten children are dismissed at 2:30 PM to parents waiting at the Large St. doors.

LABELS FOR EDUCATION PROGRAM UPDATE

Only UPCs with the Labels for Education logo on them are currently accepted to redeem for points in this program. Campbell began removing this logo from their products in August, 2016, so by August, 2017 they expected that there would be no more labels available on their products in stores. However, the Labels for Education program will still accept any labels that you may have at home. Please check your kitchen drawers and send in any labels that you may find hiding in there. We will send a final shipment of Labels on December 19. Then the Labels for Education program will be dissolved.

BOX TOPS/LABELS COLLECTION INCENTIVES

This year, Mr. Bellantoni has announced two incentives to help boost student/family support of the Box Tops/Labels programs: 1) at the end of each month, the class with the greatest number of Box Tops/Labels submitted that month will win a pizza party; 2) at the end of each month, the student in each class who brings in the highest total of Box Tops/Labels that month will receive a Dress-Down Pass. School-appropriate clothing must be worn when a student uses this pass. The student must clear the use of this pass with his or her teacher the day before they use it to make sure that no school activity is happening that day that warrants the wearing of the regular school uniform. These passes can be used any time until the end of the school year. However, in order for your child to receive credit for their Box Tops/Labels, their name and room number **MUST** be written on the bag or envelope that you send in to school. If it is not on there, they will not count towards the child's total. Thank you for supporting this important endeavor.
