New Arrival Procedure

Thank you to all of you who are abiding by the new arrival procedure. It is improving every day and we have had many comments as to how much easier and safer it is to drop off the children. Please remember that if you are driving your child to school in the morning, no student will be allowed to be dropped off on Shelmire Ave. or Vista St. **All students except PreK 3 and PreK 4 must be dropped off in the school parking lot.** You are asked to enter the parking lot using the Large Street driveway proceed to the designated “Drop off Area” and exit using the Vista Street exit. When exiting the Vista Street driveway it is suggested that you turn right to make exiting safer and faster. Please follow the car line moderators’ directions to proceed to the front of the line and do not allow your children to exit the car before a moderator is there to help them out. In order to avoid accidents, please stay in the line procession until exiting the schoolyard.

All walkers must also enter through the doors at the ramp from Vista St. If they are walking from Castor, we suggest that they walk in front of the church and go down Vista St. to the ramp rather than try to cut through the church parking lot.

New Pretzel Procedure

If you have more than one child, each child must return a separate form. You may return the total amount of money with the oldest child but please make a note of the payment on each child’s order form.
