Scholarships for the 2018-2019 School Year

Thank you to all of you who have applied for scholarships. Though there is no guarantee that you will receive one, we will try our best to give everyone a scholarship. The scholarship amount from BLOCS and/or BRIDGE will depend on the OSTC/EITC moneys that have been designated for Resurrection Regional Catholic School.

In the summer, the rectory will be notified of all scholarship amounts and the adjustments will be made to your tuition. Keep in mind that, if you are paying in full, the scholarship amount will be deducted from the full tuition, not the 10% discounted amount.

Recipients of the **Children’s Scholarship Fund of Philadelphia** should have been notified by CSFP of the scholarship amount they will be receiving. If you do not know what that amount is, email agarvey@resurrectschool.org. Half of the scholarship amount will be applied in the fall and the remaining half in the spring.

BLOCS and BRIDGE FOUNDATION Scholarships will be determined in the summer. You will receive a letter from school informing you of the amount you will be receiving. Amounts will vary based on your need and the scholarship moneys available to our school.
